

¹⁾ This interdisciplinary program, directed by the Graduate College, prepares health professionals to become competent in the methodological foundations and conduct of clinical and translational research.

2) The basic science graduate programs of Biochemistry and Molecular Biology, Cell Biology, Microbiology and Immunology, Physiology, Pathology, and Neuroscience offer a one-year interdisciplinary curriculum to prepare biomedical doctoral students for career choices. After the first year of coursework that includes up to four laboratory rotations in varied departments, students select a department and mentor, then matriculate into a specific degree-granting program to complete the Ph.D. degree.
